Baron Albert Von Schrenk Notzing, a german aristocratic, was a pioneer in psychological research. The study of telekinesis and the subsequent discussion on an ectoplasms made him famous. He participated in several séances and became convinced that the phenomenas of ectoplasm occurred during the various sessions, there were physical manifestations of the subconscious of the subject-medium.

He also noted that even the presence emerged during the séances had ways, thoughts and intelligence similar to those of the participants. The ectoplasms, then, was a physical manifestation of thoughts, memories and unconscious experiences of the participants at the meeting.

The spirit becomes a materialization of the collective unconscious.
